The Curbside Object Status Tag facilitates the smooth operation of the informal sidewalk gift economy. By indicating the condition of an object, passers-by can make an informed decision about whether to take the object home with them. Simply check the appropriate boxes on the other side of this tag then affix it to the object that is to be placed on the curb.

## Tips:

- Bundle all loose parts, cords and hardware to make it easy for people to carry all the objects together or place all loose objects in a cardboard box.
- Avoid putting out objects on a rainy or snowy day.
- Allow enough time before garbage pick-up for passers-by to find your object.
- Consider taking broken electronic devices to an e-waste drop off center.
- Present the object in a tidy fashion to avoid getting a summons from the Sanitation Dept.
